Respect CODE OF CONDUCT

The following is to explain what is expected from Players over the forthcoming season

PLAYERS

- Must comply with the rules of the game, show good sportsmanship and observe fair play at all times.
- Show respect for fellow team members, management, opponents and officials.
- Show respect for both our own and opponents facilities and equipment.
- Recognise that the team is the star and not the individual.
- Be aware that you have been chosen to represent your club and behave accordingly.
- Be punctual for both matches and training and to inform managers if unable to attend either. (Always wear shin pads)
- Pay club membership by the start of the season - (Any player not paid up to date will not play in matches or train).
- Most importantly - enjoy your football.

On and Off the field, I will:

- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Promote Fair Play
- Abide by the match officials decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on other participants, facility users or neighbours
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment
- Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my Coach/Manager with respect.
- Remember we all make mistakes.
- Win or loose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee before or at the end of every game.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a warning from the coach
- Receive a written warning from the club committee
- Be required to attend a FA education course
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Not be selected for the team
- Be required to serve a suspension
- Be fined
- Be required to leave the club

In addition:

- The FA/CountyFA could impose a fine and suspension against my club
- All kit must be returned if I leave South Molton FC.
